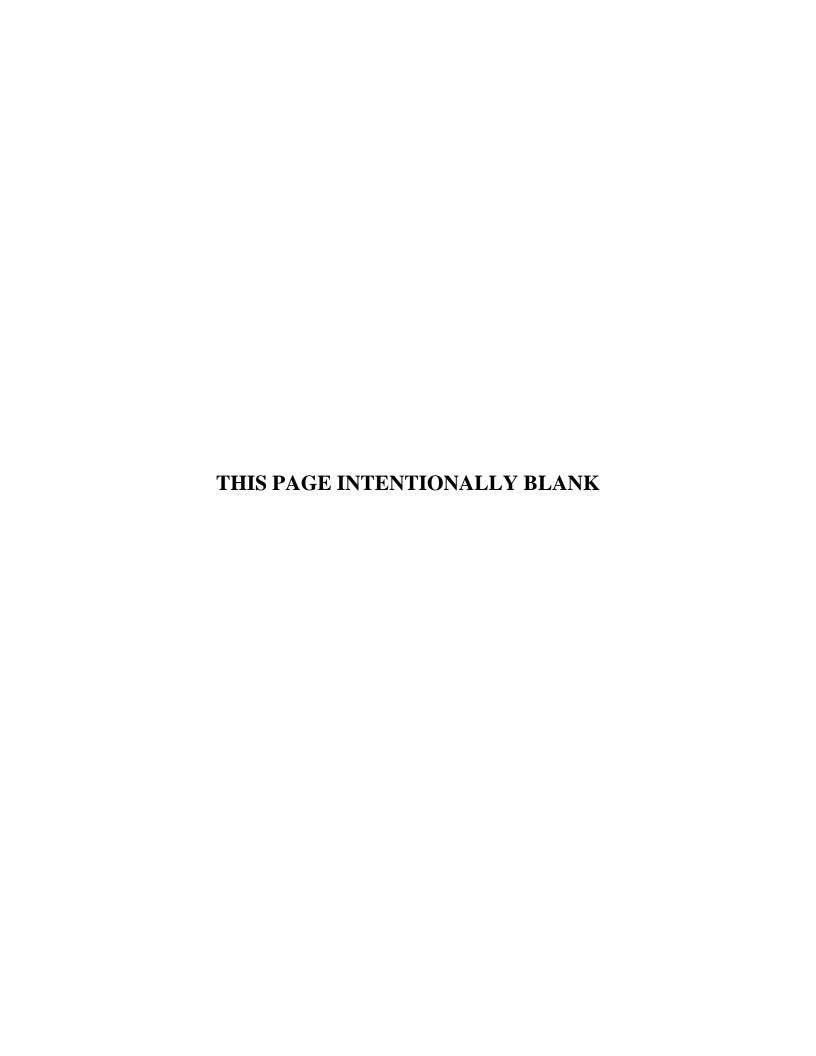

Chief Miles reviewed the Chief Examines report with the Commissioners. Chief Miles shared that FF/EMT position had been announced and currently had 8 applications. Chief Miles distributed the hiring timeline with the Commissioners.

VIII. CIVIL SERVICE RULES DISCUSSION

After brief discussion, the Commission agreed to allow the District to have flexibility when publishing vacancy announcements. Chairman Thomas called for a motion to adopt the amended language to Civil Service Rule VII, Section 1: Examination Announcements. Commissioner Dye made a motion to adopt the amended language as written. Commissioner Redling seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Current Projects:

• FF/EMT Testing Process

Meetings/Activities:

- Missed August Civil Service Meeting-Deployed to Lookout Fire
- August 30th: FF/EMT application deadline
- August 31st: Reviewed 23 submitted applications. 7 applications didn't meet minimum qualifications for testing.
- Sept 11th: FF/EMT Exam. Five qualified candidates dropped from the process.
 One candidate did not show. Nine candidates were tested.
- Sept 12th: Completed scoring. Three candidates failed the exam by obtaining scores lower than 70%
- Sept 14th: Scores and rankings sent to six eligible candidates and three noneligible candidates. The candidates have ten business days to contest their scores/ranking and 30 days to review scores.
- Plans to certify the list of Eligible on September 18th at the Civil Service Meeting
