CHIEF'S REPORT

- Marion County Radio Project Update: The county has completed a bid process and will soon be starting work at the Eastview site as well as at Woodburn PD/ METCOM. We have been working closely with project leaders to ensure no disruption to our radio system occurs during the work.
- New IP phones have been added to replace landline phones at stations 2,3 & 9. This will result in significant savings for the district regarding phone bills.
- Civil Service meeting scheduled for 4/9/2026, certification of the new FF/EMT hiring list is on the agenda.
- B487 was sent out for repairs, it was determined that the engine damage was severe and engine replacement is indicated.

ASSISTANT CHIEF'S REPORT

- Please ensure ESO reports are being completed and crews are added to all responding units.
- We will be looking at adopting the Marion Polk fire rescue protocols. If we do these will replace a number of our operational guidelines. This will put us on the same page both operationally and communication wise with those other agencies on them. More information to come.
- New B407 / B427 Project Update: Chief Terhaar has completed fabrication of the front bumper and roll over protection for B407, currently the items are being painted and will soon be installed. The B427 chassis and slip-in unit are expected to arrive soon (any day now) and the bed is completed and ready to be installed.
