



## Resident Volunteer Position Announcement

The Silvertown Fire District is currently seeking motivated individuals to join as Resident Volunteer Firefighters (RV). The position is for a two-year program, with a possibility to extend to 3-years, depending on the educational program(s) the RV has enrolled in. The RV will be assigned to a rotating 24/48 shift schedule. During assigned shifts, the RV will respond to calls for service and participate in drills/training.

**The Silvertown Fire District will provide Firefighting PPE (structural and wildland), uniforms, sleeping quarters, laundry facilities, Wi-Fi, commercial kitchen, training facilities, and certification training! Full-time living arrangements are available and encouraged! The Fire District will reimburse up to 12 credit hours per academic term, up to a maximum of the current in-state tuition rate per credit hour! We also pay a stipend for each "Response for Service" as well as trainings/drills attended!**

**18-minute drive time to the Chemeketa Brooks Campus.**

### Minimum Qualifications:

- Valid Driver's License.
- At least 18 years of age.
- High school diploma or GED.
- A driving record that is insurable by Silvertown Fire District's insurance carrier.
- Full-time enrollment in a Fire Suppression or EMS Program at **any** college.
